Deacon Jim's "A Moment with Our Lady"

In Tampa, Florida, policemen were incredulous when the management of a hotel reported an assault by a well-known criminal.

They found a man crying and lying on the floor of a hotel room and next to him, two women praying aloud...In the written report, the two women stated: "The hoodlum forcibly entered the room, threatening us with his gun and forcing us to lie down on the ground"...

While he searched everywhere, looking for valuables, the two victims began to pray aloud for his soul. Although he was a hardened criminal, the young man was shaken and burst into sobs.
