# Deacon Jim's "A Moment with Our Lady"

The Shrine of Mary Help of Christians in Zo-se is of national importance. Located in the heart of Catholic China, it rises on a hill a few kilometers from Shanghai. In 1844, a missionary, noticing a Buddhist temple in ruins, had the idea of building a shrine in honor of Mary. His dream came true in 1867, and soon Christians went there on pilgrimage.

It was in that church that in 1924 the Apostolic Delegate in China, all the bishops, and many priests gathered to officially consecrate China to the Virgin Mary. The shrine was declared a minor basilica in 1942 by Pope Pius XII.

After the military victory of Mao Tse-tung, the shrine was desecrated and was closed for twenty years. But the courage of more than thirty thousand pilgrims broke the deadlock.

From 15-17 March 1978, pilgrims entered the dilapidated church and discreetly placed a small statue of the Virgin inside. The authorities did nothing to stop them because they were peaceful. After it reopened for worship, the shrine was entrusted to the priests of the national Church, at that time separated from Rome, who in 1990 ordered a special statue of Mary Help of Christians from Turin.

# Saint Emily de Vialar

Feast Day - June 17

Emily was the only daughter of a French baron. At 15 she left school in Paris to become her widowed father's companion in Gaillac. Despite his wishes, Emily would not marry, and for 15 years tended neglected children and the poor. In 1832, when her maternal grandfather left her a fortune, she bought a large house in Gaillac, which became the first home of the Congregation of Sisters of St. Joseph of the Apparition. In 1835, the order won approval and Emily and 17 other sisters professed vows. Their charisms were care of the needy and education. Emily oversaw the formation of 40 houses, before dying from complications of a hernia she'd gotten in her youth while doing a good deed.
